### WINTER/SPRING NATIONAL MEETS

The Gulf Handbook specifies that a swimmer will be fully reimbursed for either the Junior or Senior meet in December or the NSCA meet in the Spring, but not both.

### SUMMER NATIONAL MEETS WITH OLYMPIC TRIALS

For Olympic Trials, US Open, and Juniors, the Gulf Policy has been to fund 100% of the most expensive meet and then 50% of the 2nd most expensive meet. That is, if someone went to two or three of the summer meets, we would calculate the amount for each of their reimbursement requests, then give them 100% of the largest request and 50% of the next largest request.

We think that is very reasonable, and we should do it again for 2012.
