Directions: Traveling from I-45 just north of The Woodlands, take FM 1488 West Approx. 15 mile toward Magnolia. The pool is located on the Magnolia High School Campus (On the East Side of the High School). The School is located on the North side of FM 1488 at the corner of FM 1488 & FM 149. Traveling from the West, take Beltway 8 North to Highway 249. Take 249 north approx. 25 miles to FM 149 (Approx. 3 miles north of Tomball). Turn right on FM149 and go north to FM 1488. The pool is located on the Magnolia High School campus (On the East Side of the High School). The School is located on the North side of FM 1488 at the corner of FM 1488 & FM 149.

POOL: Eight lane, 25 yard indoor pool with 5 continuous warm up-down lanes at far end. Pool has competitor non-turbulent lane lines, an 8 line LED CTS Scoreboard and non-slip touch pads.

TIME AND DATE: This is a Timed Finals Meet.
Friday February 26, 2010
Friday: warm-up at 5:00 p.m., meet starts at 6:30 p.m. (TIMED FINAL EVENTS)
Saturday and Sunday February 27-28, 2010
Saturday and Sunday: warm-up at 7:30 a.m., meet starts at 9:00 a.m. (TIMED FINAL EVENTS). Split warm-ups will be in effect, with assignments posted on the Gulf Swimming web site.

Lane assignments for warm-ups and timing will be designated in the psych sheet, and posted on the Gulf Swimming website at least three days prior to the start of the meet.

MEET TYPE: This meet will be run utilizing the “Flyover Starts” procedures unless a waiver is received from the Technical Planning Committee Chairman. At the conclusion of each heat, the swimmers shall remain in the water until after the next heat is started. Coaches, please remind your swimmers of the “Flyover Start” procedures.

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES: See attached Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures.

SEEDING: The meet will be a deck-seeded meet. Coaches please inform your swimmers of seeding on deck rules.

CHECK-IN: All swimmers must check in with the Clerk of the Course for all events. Swimmers are required to circle-in at least 45 minutes before their event. After the events are officially closed, no one may check in or scratch. After circling in, failure to appear at the starting blocks will result in the swimmer being assessed a \$5.00 fine, payable to Gulf Swimming Administrative Vice-Chairman, Henry Clark, for each event in which he/she fails to appear. Relay cards must be turned in to the Clerk of Course by 10:00 AM or the entry will be considered scratched.

ON-DECK ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted each day up to 30 minutes before the start of the meet. Those swimmers missing the 6:00 p.m. Friday Feb 19th deadline may enter the meet on deck in the following manner:

1. Swimmers must pay double the entry fee at the time of entry.
2. Swimmers must supply completed entry forms entered at the swimmers' best times. The swimmers will be seeded into the events according to their best times.
3. Swimmers must enter all events for the day thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the day's first event.
4. Swimmers must be qualified to swim the event entered.
5. Swimmers must not exceed the allotted number of events allowed each day.
6. Swimmers who on-deck to change an entry time in an event already entered must circle-in on the posted circle-in sheets. The new time will be used for seeding. The on-deck entry fees still apply to these swimmers.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

Entry Times: Swimmers must enter at their best time. Entry times must be submitted in the course at which the best time was achieved – short course yards (Y), short course meters (S), or long course meters (L). Do not convert meter times to yard times. If entries are made by paper (not using Hy-Tek), swimmers should indicate on their entry the course at which the entry time was made (i.e., Y, S, or L). Swimmers must have swum the events entered some time prior to entering this meet. Swimmers may not enter with no time (NT).

8 & unders must have a previous time to enter any of the 50-yard events, the 500-yd freestyle, and the 100-yd IM; No Times (“NT”) are not allowed for these events.

8 & unders must enter the 100-yd freestyle event with an available 100-yd freestyle time, but if unavailable, they may enter with a “NT” if they have a previous 50-yd freestyle time.

8 & unders may enter the 100-yd butterfly, backstroke or breaststroke events if they have a previous 50-yd butterfly, backstroke or breaststroke time, and will be entered in the meet as “NT”.

8 & unders may enter the 200-yd freestyle or 200-yd IM events with a “NT” if they have a previous 100-yd freestyle or 100-yd IM time

Cut-off Times: There are no cut-off times.

Qualifying Times: There are no qualifying times.

Age: As of February 26, 2010.

Number of Events: Swimmers may compete in up to three (3) individual events per day and up to one (1) relay event per day. The 10 & Under 500 free and the 400 IM do not count as one of the three (3) events per day.

Deadline: Entries must be in the hands of the Meet Entry Chairman no later than 6:00 p.m. on Friday February 19, 2010. No late entries will be accepted. Do not send entries via Federal Express, etc., that require a signature; if you must send your entries by express mail, please indicate that a signature is NOT required. Entries: All teams entering 10 or more swimmers MUST submit their entries on a diskette or electronically via e-mail, using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager/Team Manager computer software, along with a hard copy printout of the entries. Teams without Hy-Tek should submit their entries on the enclosed Entry Form. A \$25.00 fee must be included with the entry fees for teams that enter 10 or more swimmers using an entry form only (without sending Hy-Tek files). Include relays and relay-only swimmers on your completed entry form, diskette, or electronic submission.

Teams may electronically mail their Meet Manager files. Payments for the electronic entries and a hard copy print-out of the entries must be submitted or postmarked no later than 24 hours after the entry deadline as stated in the Meet Invitation.

Eligible Teams: Gulf Group A Teams Only: AGS, BBSC, CSC, CFSC, LSST, MAC, SS, SSAN, TAMU, TWST

Fees: Six dollars (\$6.00) per Individual Event and nine dollars and fifty cents (\$9.50) for each Relay event plus a two dollar (\$2.00) per swimmer Facility Surcharge fee. Make checks payable to CFSC. Entry fees must accompany entries, if delivered by any method other than email.

AWARDS: Individual events: medals 1st – 3rd, ribbons 4th – 8th place. Relay events: medals 1st, ribbons 2nd – 3rd place. Plaques will be awarded to the boy and girl in each age group earning the highest points. Combined team awards for 1 – 3 place.

SCORING:

Individual Events:	9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay Events:	18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Scoring: 8&U events will be scored as BB/B. 9-10, 10&U and 11-12 **50 & 100** events will be scored A/BB/B. 10&U and 11-12 **200, 400 & 500** events will be scored A/BB.

RULES AND SANCTIONS: The 2009-10 USA Swimming and Gulf Swimming rules will apply. The meet will be held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Gulf Swimming. No entries can be accepted unless the entrant is either registered or certified by USA Swimming. Gulf Zone B, C and D teams are not eligible to swim at this meet. The three (3) event rule and up/down rule do not apply. Swimmers may not enter with no time (NT).

POOL MEASUREMENT: The competition course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Rule 104.2.2(C). The pool will be measured before the competition begins to ensure that the course length is correct.

WATER DEPTH: 202.3.6 The water depth of the competition course is 13 feet measured from 1 meter to 5 meters on the starting end of the course, and 5 feet measured from 1 meter to 5 meters on the turning end of the course

TIMING SYSTEM: A Colorado Model 6000 electronic timing system with electronic scoreboard will be used. Two watches per lane will be used as a back-up. Teams will be required to furnish timers based on their percentage of swims at the meet. Timing assignments will be published in the psych sheet. Swimmers in the 500 Free and 400 IM must provide 2 timers and a lap counter where applicable.

POOL DECK RESTRICTION: Because of USA Swimming Insurance Safety Regulations, the swimming pool deck, during the operation of all Gulf Swimming sanctioned meets, is closed to all persons except swimmers, coaches, marshals, officials, meet personnel, and timers. All registered non-athletes are required to display their current USA Swimming registration card. If you are asked to leave the deck by any registered personnel, please do so. It is for your safety.

Coaches and Officials must present their membership cards in order to receive complimentary Psych Sheets and for admission to the Hospitality Room.

PROOF OF TIME: Any swimmer that cannot prove that he/she was eligible to swim an event will be fined \$20.00 for each event he/she fails to prove. The fine or proof of time is sent to the Administrative Vice-Chairman, Henry Clark.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES: Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition and for providing their own assistant or equipment. However, Coaches/Swimmers may contact the Meet Director at least two weeks in advance of the meet to reserve Gulf Swimming equipment (remote strobe).

CONCESSIONS: Lenny's Sub Shop will have a full line of breakfast and lunch items available for purchase at the meet. Menu items include breakfast burritos, pancakes, Philly cheesesteak, either beef or chicken, Cheeseburger, Fajita Taco, either beef or chicken, cold Subs and all beef hotdogs.



HOSPITALITY: A hospitality room will be available for Coaches and Officials.

MERCHANDISE: D&J Sports will be at the meet selling a complete line of swim gear and apparel.

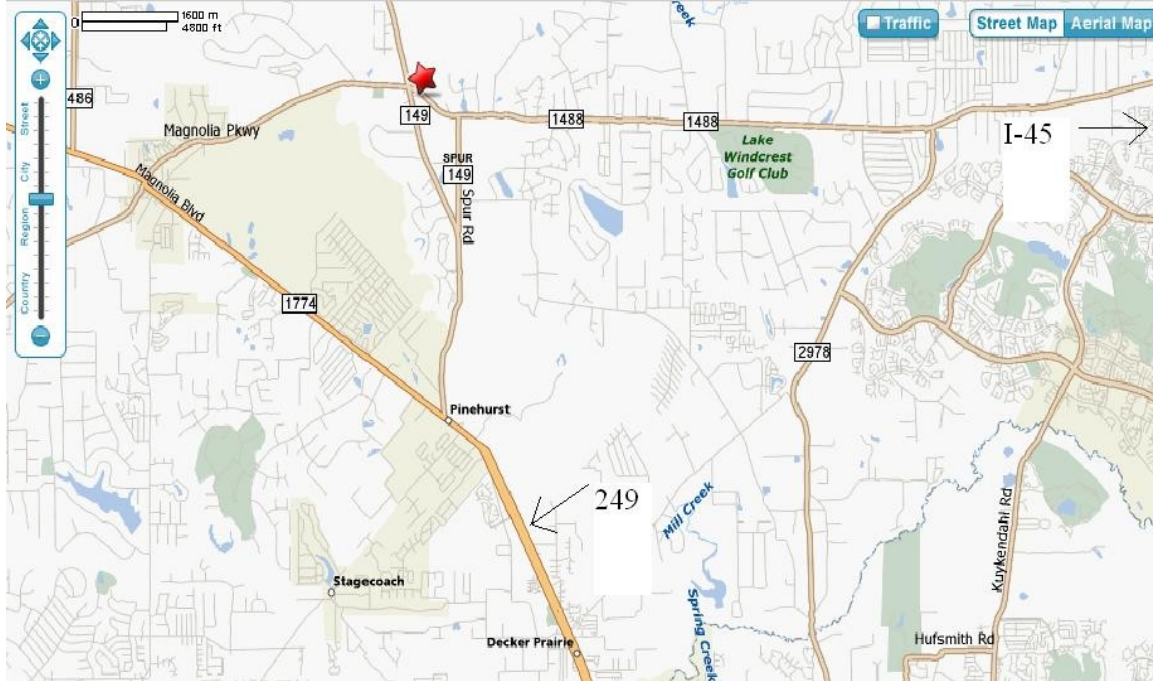
