ATHLETE REGISTRATION COORDINATOR

Annette Leach There are a total of 7,664 athletes registered for 2013, with

7,157 as regular registration, 306 outreach and 201 individual seasonal. This is a 7% increase from the total swimmers registered in 2012. Outreach reimbursement for 2013 short

course for 1,026 events was \$6,121.

NON-ATHLETE REGISTRATION COORDINATOR

Coaches encouraged to review information from USA Swimming regarding the Foundations of Coaching Testing requirements – there are big changes.

Rick Tobin USA Swimming will require that all sanctioned meets have a

certified Administrative Official/Referee appointed to the meet and in attendance at the meet. We have until Sept 1, 2013 to get people certified to this new position. We will

receive certification guidelines from USA-S soon, and will determine what requirements will be needed for certification. We will post this information on the Gulf website soon.

TECHNICAL PLANNING COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

The preliminary draft of 2013 – 2014 Meet Schedule was presented. It was moved, seconded, and passed to approve. For multi-venue/host Gulf meets, the procedure that all entries will be sent to central entry and allocated to all hosts equally was moved, seconded, and passed to approve. All Gulf sponsored meets will be exempt from the 4 hour rule fine was moved, seconded, and passed to approve, however Gulf sponsored meets should be planned to be less than 4 hour sessions. All Gulf Open and Champs meet weekends shall be protected against any other club sponsored meets – was moved, seconded, and passed to approve.

Henry Clark made a motion to waive the 4 hour rule penalty for 2013 long course club sponsored meets. This will allow swimmers the chance to swim all events entered. Club hosted meets should be planned to be less than 4 hour sessions. Motion was moved, seconded, and passed to approve.

GULF SWIMMING FUNDED BOARD-DESIGNATED OPERATING RESERVE 2012-2013

I. Philosophy

The establishment and maintenance of a funded Board-Designated Operating Reserve is a high priority. This will enable Gulf Swimming to support strategic business practices and to:

- A. Manage cash flow interruptions.
- B. Meet commitments, obligations or other contingencies.
- C. Generate investment income.

II. Policy

The purpose of this policy is to establish and maintain a funded Board-Designated Operating Reserve, unencumbered and uncommitted, at a level relative to the annual program funding and the costs of operating and maintaining the organization.

The Operating Reserve is intended to serve a dynamic role and is available to be utilized as needed rather than being static, devoted only to generating interest income.

III. Definitions

- A. **Board-Designated Operating Reserve** Amounts reported in the Total Assets section of the balance sheet and identified as Board-Designated Operating Reserve.
- B. Costs of Operating and Maintaining the Organization Gulf Swimming's net expenses for Operations as reflected by the approved annual budget.
- C. **Funded Board-Designated Operating Reserve** A fund consisting of liquid assets and investments. Liquid assets are those that may be converted to cash quickly and easily. It is not required that Board-Designated Operating Reserve be physically segregated in a separate bank or investment account although Gulf Swimming may decide to do so.

IV. Strategies and Procedures

- A. Board-Designated Operating Reserve shall be accounted for separate and apart from Undesignated Operating Funds.
- B. The Investment Committee will have the responsibility for developing and recommending policies and guidelines for the investment of the Operating Reserve assets and the Board of Directors will approve such policies and guidelines.
- C. The Operating Reserve goal will be to achieve and maintain at least twelve months of Operating Costs as defined in Section III.

V. Sources

Assets for the **Board-Designated Operating Reserve** accounts will come from the retained earnings of the organization.

VI. Uses

- A. Internal line of credit for use to financially operate the organization.
- B. Funds to meet unfunded and unexpected organization needs.
- C. Funds for emergency and emerging needs of subsidiaries.
- D. Funds to make up a deficiency in budgeted revenue, either in results or collection experience.

VII. Governance

Depletion of the Operating Reserve will be evidenced by a negative balance in Net Income. The procedure for approving use of the Operating Reserve Funds will be as follows:

- A. As projected in the budget as approved by the House of Delegates.
- B. By approval of the Board of Directors to fund unusual expenditures out of reserves.
- C. By extraordinary expenses or loss of revenue and (or) investment losses. In this case, the following procedure will be followed:
 - 1. Treasurer will inform the other members of the Investment Committee.
 - 2. Treasurer will inform the Board of Directors at its next scheduled meeting. If the Operating Reserve is and has been less than 75% of the targeted reserve level for two consecutive years, the Board of Directors, in the absence of any extraordinary circumstances, will adopt an operational budget that includes a projected surplus sufficient to rebuild the Operating Reserve Fund to its targeted reserve level over the following two years.

VIII. Maintenance

The status of the funded **Board-Designated Operating Reserve** will be calculated at the end of each fiscal year based upon audited financial results.

Operating Reserve Ratio Calculation

The calculation formula will be based upon amounts defined in Section III as follows:

<u>Unrestricted</u>, <u>Board-Designated Operating Reserve as of 12/31</u> = [Budgeted Annual Operating Budget]

Example: \$730,705 = 2011 Budget

The adequacy of the Board-Designated Operating Reserve will be determined as follows:

The Operating Reserve Ratio Calculation will be presented to the Investment Committee following approval of the financial audit results by the Audit Committee. The Treasurer will consider the adequacy of the Operating Reserve amount and will recommend any changes as deemed necessary.

IX. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed every four years by the Treasurer or sooner if conditions warrant. Any changes thereto will be approved by the Board of Directors.

Selection criteria will be top two IMX scores for SC 2012-13 (date for meets ending March 12) in each age group M/F 11,12,13,14. Age will be considered age at end of meet selection date. Swimmer contribution will be \$200 each and travel will be by van. Two Gulf coaches will be needed for this Camp.

2013 Age Group Zones Championship: Special thank you to Lindsie Micko (FCST) for taking on the head coaching role and planning for the Zones meet this summer. She has done an outstanding job of organizing the trip and we look forward to a highly motivated coaching staff and Gulf team of swimmers going to Greenville SC July 29-Aug 4th.
